ORDINANCE NO. 1085

**AN ORDINANCE VACATING THE ENTIRE 40-FOOT FLOODWAY RESERVE:
THE ENTIRE 40-FOOT FLOODWAY RESERVE ON LOT 1, BLOCK 1, ALL
BOER LAND ADDITION, SEDGWICK COUNTY, KANSAS**

RECITALS

On August 16, 2021, the Governing Body of the City of Maize, Kansas (the "City") held a public hearing concerning a petition (the "Petition") filed by James Voegeli Living Trust praying for the vacation of the following described land:

The entire 40-foot Floodway Reserve on Lot 1, Block 1, All Boer Land Addition,
Sedgwick County, Kansas,

(the "floodway reserve").

After the public hearing was concluded, the City Council adopted Vacation Order V-03-021 (the "Vacation Order").

In the Vacation Order, the City Council, after being duly and fully informed as to understanding the true nature of the Petition and the propriety of granting the vacation of the floodway reserve, made the following findings:

"1. That due and legal notice has been given by publication as required by law, by publication in *The Mount Hope Clarion* on July 15, 2021, which was at least 20 days prior to the public hearing.

2. No private rights will be injured or endangered by the vacation of the above-described floodway reserve, and the public will suffer no loss or inconvenience thereby.

3. In justice to the petitioner(s), the prayer of the petition ought to be granted.

4. No written objection to said vacation has been filed with the City Clerk by any owner or adjoining owner who would be a proper party to the petition.

5. The vacation of the floodway reserve described herein should be approved."

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF MAIZE, SEDGWICK COUNTY, KANSAS:


Section 1. The findings made by the City Council in the Vacation Order numbered 1 through 5 as cited above are adopted as the findings of the Governing Body.

Section 2. Based upon the findings numbered 1 through 5 of the Vacation Order as cited above and pursuant to authority set forth in K.S.A. 12-505 the Utility Easement is vacated.


